

## Power of Attorney

are hereby granted power of attorney

1. to file and conduct lawsuits (in accordance inter alia with §§ 81 ff. ZPO - German Code of Civil Procedure), including the authority to file and to withdraw counter-suits;
2. to file motions in divorce cases and the legal consequences of divorce (ancillary matters), to conclude agreements on these ancillary matters of divorce, as well as to file motions/applications for information related to pensions and any other discovery;
3. to represent and defend in criminal cases and administrative fine matters (§§ 302, 374 StPO German Code of Criminal Procedure), including preliminary proceedings, as well as to represent pursuant to § 411 II of the German Code of Criminal Procedure (in the case of absence) and, with special authorization, also according to §§ 233 1, 234 German Code of Criminal Procedure, to file demands for prosecution and any other relevant motions provided by the Code of Criminal Procedure and motions pursuant to the Law and Compensation for Wrongful Prosecution, particularly in relation to the compensation amount;
4. to represent in all other proceedings and all other extrajudicial negotiations;
5. to negotiate, agree, enter into and dissolve/annul contractual relationships (contracts) and to state submit and receive unilateral declarations of intent (e.g. notice of termination) in relation with the matter mentioned above under "concerning".

The power of attorney is valid for all instances and for every and all ancillary or accessory or subsequent proceeding (e.g. attachment and temporary injunction, proceedings related to decisions concerning the determination of costs, execution, intervention, compulsory sale and administration, receivership and depositing, and bankruptcy proceedings in regard to the adversary). The Power of Attorney particularly includes the authority to serve and to be served documents, to transfer the Power of Attorney in whole or partially to others (Substitute Power of Attorney), to file, withdraw and waive appeals, to settle any lawsuit or extrajudicial negotiation by means of compromise, waivers or acknowledgments, to receive monies, valuables and documents as well as the subject matter in dispute, any amounts reimbursed by the opposing party or the judicial cashier or other authorities and to inspect all related files.
